

GUIDE LINES FOR WIDOW PENSION

Nair Service Society Delhi (Regd) is devoted to the promotion of human welfare and the advancement of social reforms. We are committed to the upliftment of poor, downtrodden and deserving human beings from all walks of life, without considering their cast and creed. It is our vision to join the mankind to try our maximum for elimination of pain and suffering of the underprivileged human beings. Under the Project of humanitarian assistance of NSS Delhi, in addition to various existing schemes, we have decided to introduce Widow Pension Scheme.

What is the Widow Pension Scheme?

Widow Pension Scheme a new project aimed to help the deserving and eligible widows seeking financial assistance.

The scheme is only for those who are not availing any financial assistance from any other source.

The pension will be paid monthly / quarterly @ Rs.500.00 per month strictly under the following conditions:

1. She (the widow) should be a bonafide resident of Delhi and without adequate means of subsistence and :
2. Morally straight;
3. Her family income from all sources should not exceed Rs.48,000.00 per year

Disbursement of pension in terms of amount, date, time etc. is limited within the discretionary power of Nair Service Society Delhi.

How to apply:

1. Those who wish to apply for Widow Pension Scheme have to submit the Prescribed Application Form duly filled in and signed along with three attested photographs and with proof of residence. One photo has to be affixed on the Application Form and two photographs have to be enclosed therewith.
2. All the applications have to be routed through concerned Karayogams with recommendations by the Chairman / Secretary after getting it approved by Area Executive Committee in its meeting.
3. Application should be addressed to the General Secretary, Nair Service Society Delhi (Regd) and should be submitted well within the time as announced in time to time.

Stopping of Assistance:

NSS Delhi shall have the authority to stop the pension at if the application is found incomplete or wrong at any stage or the information given by the women is found incorrect or false through any reliable source or at the time of remarriage or improvement in her source of income.

No pensioner has any right to claim the pension at any point when the same is delayed / abandoned/cancelled.

All final decisions on the Widow Pension Scheme are vested with NSS Delhi.
